IV. WHAT IS IT.?

Look at the words written in **column 1**. How were they written?

The words that are written in column 2 are called proper nouns. **Proper nouns are** words that show the name of a **particular or specific** person, place, animal or an event. The first letter of proper nouns is written in a **capital letter**.

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The words written in column 1 are called common nouns. **Common nouns** name **any** person, place, thing, animal or event. Let us look at more examples below:

COMMON NOUNS	PROPER NOUNS
Computer	Samsung
School	Valenzuela Central Elementary School
Day	Tuesday
Movie	Batman
Teacher	Miss Anabel Alfonso

Samsung is a brand of a particular computer.

Valenzuela Central Elementary School is the name of a school in Valenzuela City.

Tuesday is a particular day in a week.

Batman is the title of a particular movie.

Miss Anabel Alfonso is the name of a particular teacher.
